EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

PLAY BASED AND CHILD DIRECTED CURRICULUM

Children's learning is central to everything we do. Children are encouraged to participate in a variety of activities to extend and develop their knowledge and skills. at KOQP, we acknowledge all children being highly competent researchers, inquirers, adventurers, learners and communicators.

In order to facilitate every child's learning and development, our curriculum is carefully designed based on National Quality_Eramework_(NQF), National Quality Standard (NQS), the Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF) and the Victorian Early Years Learning and Development Framework (VEYLDF).

| 6:30am - 7-45am | Arrival / Welcome | Children arrive, educators welcome the children to the group/family setting in the Kindergarten room. Activities are suitable for all age groups. Breakfast is served based on each child's morning routine. |
| 8:00am - 9:45 am | Free Play | Indoor planned program, Group Time, and self-directed play. Nappies are changed |
| 9:45 to 10:00am | Group time | Pack up experiences (encourage children to help). Sunscreen applied 20 minutes before going outside, hats and jackets (encourage children to dress themselves, weather appropriate). |
| 10:00 to 11:00 am | Outdoor Play | Outdoor planned program and self-directed play |
| 11:00 to 11:30am | Lunch Time | Children eat with their peers and afterwards participate in cleaning up. They pack away their chairs, put their bowls and drink bottles away, wipe the area they were sitting in etc. This develops children's independence. |
| 11:30 to 11:45am | Nappy changing/getting ready for bed | Nappies are changed, face and hands are washed, children clean their own dishes children prepare for sleep |
| 12:00pm to 2:00pm | Nap Time | Rest/sleep time. |
| 2:00 to 2:30 pm | Afternoon tea | Drink of milk or water offered. Sunscreen applied 20 minutes before going outside, hats and jackets put on have afternoon tea (encourage child to dress themselves, weather appropriate). |
| 2:30 to 4:00 pm | Afternoon Play | Outdoor planned program and self-directed play |
| 4:00 to 4:10 pm | Nappy changing | Nappies are replaced, and hands are washed before the late snack time. |
| 4:10 to 4:45 pm | Afternoon tea | Group time and story time. Late snack time, wholemeal sandwiches are offered |
| 4:45 to 6:30 pm | Family Grouping | After sandwiched children get to play outdoor with the Quindalup children. |
